COLLETT'S SKI SAFARI – No.4

9-16 February 2019



Alta Badia, Val di Fassa, Latemar & Southern Central Dolomites

Featuring an extensive circumnavigation of the Marmolada featuring Arabba, Alta Badia, Cinque Torre, Hidden valley, Pordoi Pass, canazei, Ciampac, Buffaure, Bellamonte, Latemar, Pampeago, Obereggen, Cavalese, Cermis, San Pellegrino, Col Margherita, Cima Uoma, Falcade & Tre Valli.

Day 1: Saturday 9th February

Transfer to Arabba from Venice Marco Polo or Venice Treviso airport (flight to land before 3pm).

Meet your Collett's host ahead of an evening briefing with your ski safari guide.

Accommodation: Albergo La Baita

Day 2: Sunday 10th February

Today you will ski over Passo Campolongo into the Badia valley where the charming villages of Corvara, Colfosco and La Villa are situated. A short taxi transfer via Passo Valparola takes you to the impressive Falzarego cable car and "Cinque Torri" ski area.

Accommodation: Rifugio Lagazuoi

Day 3: Monday 11th February

From Lagazuoi, through the beautiful slopes of Val Badia, you'll come back to Arabba. You'll ski over Passo Pordoi into Val di Fassa area; from Ciampac and Boffaure you can see the west side of the Marmolada glacier.

Accommodation: Baita Cuz (TBC)

Day 4: Tuesday 12th February

In the morning transfer to Lusia area for a full day skiing. You can challenge yourself on the steepest black slope of the area, for example the "Piavac" black slope. Here you can admire the real "rocky cathedrals": Latemar, Catinaccio-Rosengarden and Pale di San Martino. They are legendary giants that magically turn pink at sunset.

Accommodation: Rifugio Lusia (TBC)

Day 5: Wednesday 13th February

In the morning transfer to Passo Rolle and San Martino di Castrozza.

San Martino di Castrozza, together with Passo Rolle, comprises the Primiero ski area. The town is surrounded by thick conifer forests in the shadow of the Pale di San Martino. This area is located in the south of Dolomiti Superski ski area, and tends to enjoy mild temperatures and sunny weather.

Accommodation: Malga Ces (TBC)

Day 6: Thursday 14th February

Malga Ces lies in a privileged location right on the slopes of Ces. From here it is possible to reach panoramic spots and breathtaking slopes, experience ski runs and delicious breaks at the huts.

Accommodation: Malga Ces (TBC)

Day 7: Friday 15th February

In the morning you'll transfer to San Pellegrino area. From Col Margherita you'll see the south side of the Marmolada glacier and from Cima Uomo you'll see the Pale di San Martino and the Civetta mountains. In the evening transfer to Canale d'Agordo.

Accommodation: Albergo alle Codole

Day 8: Saturday 16th February

Return airport transfer back to Venice Marco Polo or Venice Treviso airports. (Please do not book a flight that takes off before 11am). Any hired skis or boots will be taken back to Arabba by your ski guide.
