


COLLETT'S SKI SAFARI – Tour 3

8-15 February 2020



Featuring - Passo Campolungo, Corvara, Passo Valporola, Passo Falzarego, Cortina, Averau, Nuvolau, Val di Fassa, Ciampac, Buffaure, Catinaccio-Rosengarten, Pale di San Martino, Passo San Pellegrino, Falcade, Col Margherita & Civetta

Day 1: Saturday 8th February

Join a Collett's Transfer to Arabba from Venice Marco Polo or Venice Treviso airport.

Pick up time – no later than 3pm. In Arabba, a Collett's representative will issue your skipass, assist with any equipment hire and introduce you to your guide, who will host an initial briefing that evening.

Accommodation: Hotel in Arabba

Day 2: Sunday 9th February

We ski north out of Arabba over the Campolungo Pass and into the glorious Alta Badia, where the charming ski resorts of Corvara, Colfosco & La Villa await us. Eventually we will cross the Pralongia Plateau to Armentarola, where a short taxi transfer via Passo Valparola takes us to the Falzarego Pass with its dramatic cable car to Lagazuoi.

Accommodation: Rifugio Faloria

Day 3: Monday 10th February

Today is all about the iconic winter resort of Cortina d'Ampezzo, where the skiing is outstanding. We will ski the renowned *Olimpia*, which hosts the Ladies World Cup Downhill. Also, we will take the *Freccia nel Cielo* (Arrow in the Sky) cable car to Ra Valles, a wonderful lookout point above the entire valley of Cortina.

Accommodation: Rifugio Faloria

Day 4: Tuesday 11th February

Today we finish off in Cortina before transferring back to Passo Falzarego, so that we can ski the Cinque Torri ski area, breathtaking pistes surrounded by extraordinary rock formations and amazing views of Averau & Nuvolau.

Accommodation: Rifugio Lagazuoi

Day 5: Wednesday 12th February

First thing, we ski the magnificent Hidden Valley that takes us back into the picturesque Alta Badia and onwards back to Arabba. We pass through Arabba and out the other side heading west into the Val di Fassa, where we will explore Ciampac & Buffaure with their impressive views of the western flanks of the highest mountain Marmolada glacier. We take a short transfer in the late afternoon to the Lusia ski area.

Accommodation: Rifugio Lusia

Day 6: Thursday 13th February

Today you can challenge yourself on the steepest black slope of the area, the Piavac. Here the Dolomites take on a monumental cathedral-like form and you will be mesmerised by the Latemar, Catinaccio-Rosengarten & Pale di San Martino. These legendary giants magically turn pink at sunset.

Accommodation: Rifugio Lusia

Day 7: Friday 14th February

In the morning we transfer to Passo San Pellegrino. Today you will ski in the Tre Valli ski area. From Col Margherita you will enjoy the ever-impressive view of the sheer southern walls of the Marmolada. From Cima Uomo you will be totally absorbed by the Pale di San Martino and Monte Civetta. Then we head to the Albergo Codole where a superb final night dinner awaits us.

Accommodation: Albergo alle Codole

Day 8: Saturday 15th February

Return airport transfer back to Venice Marco Polo or Venice Treviso airports. (Please do not book a flight that takes off before 11am). Any hired skis or boots will be taken back to Arabba by your ski guide.
